

The 13,500 capacity Main Stand development at Selhurst Park will increase the ground capacity from 26,000 to 34,000, hopefully further enhancing the intense atmosphere in this most traditional of English football venues.

The proposals include lengthening the pitch to UEFA standard, extensive new facilities for general admission, premium hospitality and disabled supporters to the latest modern standards, together with a new club retail store and museum.

The dramatic external design draws on the iconography embedded in the Eagles' crest.

A 5 storey glazed central facade with barrel-vaulted arch and horizontal glazing articulation echoes the south transept section of the historic 1851 Crystal Palace Exhibition Hall (after which the club was named), and is flanked by sculpted metal clad wings concealing vertical circulation and servicing elements.

The development is the culmination of a fan-owned rebirth for AFC Wimbledon that started two decades ago.

The new stadium has an initial capacity of 9,300. The main West Stand includes four floors and three tiers with dedicated hospitality and dining spaces, fan areas, media facilities, conferencing suites, museum, club shop and 12 executive boxes looking down on to the pitch.

The stadium completes the resurrection and revival of the club, taking The Dons back to their spiritual home.



Our 25,000 capacity stadium for Le Havre AC was won in a design competition, and is Europe's first "energy positive" stadium.

The brief from the Club was to design a landmark building that would sit proudly at the entrance to the port city of Le Havre, and a venue that would deliver the "English stadia experience".

The design concept reflects the history of the Club (including its English ancestry!) and the pixelated ETFE shell cladding imitates the two core elements of sea and sky and acts as a shining beacon for the city day and night.



Our 30,000 seat football stadium at the southern gateway to Haifa was designed in partnership with local architects Mansfeld Kehat, and is a striking new landmark in the city.


The design concept combines the key stadium elements of seating bowl, roof and external envelope into a single elegant form, and the shimmering gold shingle cladding provides a strong contrast with the rugged Mount Carmel backdrop.

The stadium is home to both Maccabi Haifa and Hapoel Haifa in the Israeli Premier League, and the top quality facilities and intense atmosphere generated within the bowl has also led to it being used extensively for the Israeli national team's home fixtures.
