Giovanna Carnevali is an Urban Designer (PHD in masterplan) and an Architect with 20+ years' experience, highly motivated professional with a track record of designing, managing and delivering award winning projects. Giovanna acts as the Global Leader in Urban Design and Planning, having collaborated with some world-wide architects including Pritzker Prize winners.

During her career she has worked internationally across Europe, Russia and the Middle East. This experience includes all stages of the design process from concept through to detailed design across large multi-disciplinary teams on a variety of project sizes and building typologies.

Recently she has been managing multiple masterplanning projects simultaneously from an executive level ensuring design excellence and stakeholder management including identifying and aligning with high-level influencers and clients across both government and private sector.

Giovanna is self-starter having set up design teams from scratch both in her recent role as well in her previous roles where-in she has set up her own studio. In the most recent role, she helped in scaling up the organization from a two members team to full-fledged 30+ multidisciplinary team.

Across her career she has managed large teams, including effectively coaching, influencing and mentoring team members to ensure the timely delivery of high quality outcomes.

Giovanna, having worked across design studios, client firms, architectural foundations, has a holistic view across the entire design value chain. Each of these challenges has helped her to build up a level of expertise that can be applied to new and often unique project roles with a limited start up time.

Lead Urban Designer for reference design to new place-changing projects in Russia and Israel. Acting on behalf of the client (governmental and high class privates), she was responsible to manage a multidisciplinary team to develop and implement masterplans, architecture projects and urban standards that met the client's goals and business goals.

Key Outcomes:

• Urban Standards: Together with the National Agency for Housing Mortgage Lending (DOM.RF), she has developed with the team a system of Standards for the integrated development of territories — a toolkit of solutions for the development of a quality urban environment in Russian cities. The aim was to adapt Russian cities to the challenges of the day and help them attract an influx of human capital.
